Psalm 119:33-34 - Teach me, O LORD, the way of thy statutes [Law and Commandments]; and I shall keep [guard; obey] it unto the end. [i.e. until my eternal reward]

³⁴ **Give me understanding** [discernment], and I shall keep thy law; yea, I shall observe [keep; guard] it with my whole heart. [understanding; will; soul]

Psalm 119:73 - Thy hands have made [wrought; created] me and fashioned [prepared; established] me: **give me understanding** [discernment; instruction], that I may learn thy commandments. [be skilfull; teach]

Proverbs 14:32-34 - The wicked is driven away [thrust out; outcast; chased out] in his wickedness [sin]: but **the righteous hath hope** [refuge; trust; shelter] **in his death**. [dies in hope] ³³ Wisdom resteth in the heart of him that hath understanding: but that which is in the midst [among] of fools is made known. [a fool will be recognized by his actions and attitudes]

Righteousness exalteth a nation: but sin is a reproach to any people.

Deuteronomy 4:5-6 - Behold, I [Moses] have taught you statutes [Law and Commandments] and judgments [ordinances; i.e. God's verdict on right and wrong], even as the LORD my God commanded me, that ye should do so in the land whither ye go to possess it.

⁶ **Keep** [observe; heed] **therefore and do them**; for this is **your wisdom** [skillful use of knowledge] **and your understanding** [knowledge; insight] in the sight of the nations, which shall hear all these statutes [Law and Commandments], and say, Surely this great nation is a wise and understanding people.
